Park Ridge State School will receive**

\$208,372*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in the 2016 NAPLAN Reading Upper Two Bands (U2B) to 40% for Year 3 and 20% for Year 5.
- Increase the percentage of students in the 2016 NAPLAN Numeracy Upper Two Bands (U2B) to 30% for Year 3 and 15% for Year 5.
- Develop a learning plan for students who are below the National Minimum Standard.

Our initiatives include

- Reviewing student Numeracy performance in short term data cycles relevant to the school developed Guaranteed and Viable Mathematics program and the Professional Learning Teams' Response to Intervention Processes.
- Improving Literacy and Numeracy teaching practice through coaching and mentoring, Professional Learning Teams practice, and enhanced Professional Development and resourcing.
- Implementing Brigance Assessment Intervention Programs and additional Speech Language Pathology programs and support to improve oracy and literacy readiness in early childhood classes.
- Continuing to monitor and track student assessment data in Literacy and Numeracy to enable provision of intervention/enrichment for identified students.
